• Further monster activities - a page containing more fun ideas for you to try!



Print the monster footprints on card, cut out and place around your classroom.



Look for clues which might lead you to the monster. You might find crumbs of food, knocked over objects or even monstrous smells! List the clues which you find.





Draw and label what you think the monster looks like.





